School-wide Behavior System- Just after winter break, Corron students revisited behavior expectations in the lunchroom, at recess, in the bathrooms, and in the hallways. We reviewed behaviors to ensure that students are safe/kind, responsible, and respectful. In addition to the review of behavior expectations, a committee of teachers on the School-wide Behavior System team launched a new and exciting positive behavior reward system for students! We had an all-school assembly to get students excited and ready for the reward system that we started on Monday, January 9. Students can earn tickets throughout their school day for demonstrating positive behaviors that have been taught and reinforced school-wide. They can earn blue tickets during lunch and recess, green tickets during specials, red tickets in the hallway, and orange tickets from teachers who have opted to distribute tickets. These tickets can be redeemed for individual raffles in the lunchroom on Fridays or for whole-class rewards (Paw Prints). Classes can also earn Paw Prints for working together to demonstrate whole-class positive behavior. The initial goal for Paw Prints was 5 Paw Prints. Once classes earned 5 Paw Prints, they earned a Mannequin Challenge video! Mrs. Lowery and Mrs. Gabrielson have visited classes who have earned 5 Paw Prints to film the Mannequin Challenge. These videos have been shared with classroom teachers and classes, and are also on display in the front hallway at Corron on the TV screen. The next goal for Paw Prints requires classes to earn 10 Paw Prints (in addition to the 5 they have already earned) in order to earn a Class Spirit Day. Continue to talk with your students about the tickets they are earning and encouraging them to keep earning tickets!
