2018-2019 CUSD303 Community Preschool Program Lottery

General Information

For the 2018-2019 school year, District 303 will offer a five-day-a-week, ½ day, morning or afternoon preschool program.

The program will be open to 3-5 year old children who reside within the D303 school boundaries and who are 3 years old by September 1, 2018. Children who are 5 years old by September 1, 2018 will not be eligible for enrollment.

The tuition cost for the program is \$285 per month. A \$100 annual non-refundable registration and materials fee will also be required.*

*Tuition and registration and materials fee pending board approval

Enrollment Procedure

A proposal regarding elementary boundaries was presented to the School Board on January 18. The School Board is expected to consider the recommendation for approval at the February 12 School Board meeting.

Early Childhood will post information regarding the Community Preschool enrollment lottery after that date. Please check the main district website at www.D303.org after February 12 for details.
