PARCC TESTING - Students in grades 3 through 8 will be taking state tests in English/Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics sometime between April 4 and April 28. **At Corron we will be testing Wed., April 5 - Fri., April 21.** Additionally, students in grades 5, 8, and in their first high school biology course will be taking the Illinois Science Assessment (ISA) within that same time frame. Please consult with your school for a more specific test schedule. These assessments are designed to evaluate students’ progress toward the more rigorous state standards.

There is nothing to prepare for outside of school. Please just encourage your child to give his or her best effort and, as always, preparing your child for a good day at school begins with a good night of sleep and a nutritional breakfast.

These state tests are one of several ways student achievement is measured in CUSD 303. Your child’s daily school work, teacher comments, and report cards are also important when determining overall school achievement. If you have any questions regarding your child’s performance, be sure to talk with your child’s teacher or principal.

PARCC results will be reported in the fall on the State School Report Cards. You will also receive information about your child’s individual performance.
