By using PushCoin, you can add money to your student's lunch account, check their balance, receive email notifications when the balance becomes negative and even transfer funds from one student to another. Visit www.pushcoin.com to set up an account and have your students ID number handy. **Any balance remaining at the end of this school year transfers over automatically to the next school year!**
