Per state law, a child must be five (5) years old on or before September 1, 2018 to be eligible to attend Kindergarten during the 2018-2019 school year. Reliable proof of a child's identity and age (birth certificate, passport, visa, etc.) will be required at the time of registration as will verification of the identity of the parent or guardian. Families must provide two (2) documents as proof of residency when enrolling children. Parents have the option of an All Day Kindergarten (ADK) or Half Day Kindergarten program. All Day Kindergarten is a tuition-based program. Information regarding All Day Kindergarten tuition for the 2018-2019 school year will be available before February 1, pending Board of Education approval.
